Based on the information presented and discussed, your organization, Kappa Delta Sorority, accepts Responsibility for their actions, which constituted a violation of LSU's Code of Student Conduct, specifically:

- 10.2 Alcohol -- Not Responsible
- 10.2 Endangerment -- Not Responsible
- 10.2 Failure to Comply -- Responsible
- 10.2 Violating a Rule of the University -- Responsible

As a result of the incident that occurred on August 24, 2020, where Kappa Delta Sorority members gathered as a group on bid day when no gathering should have taken place, your organization has submitted an Enhancement Plan. The original allegation of a Kappa Delta party with alcohol was unfounded, and thus we moved to Partnership Process. This will meet the requirements of the partnership process with Greek Life/Campus Life and Student Advocacy & Accountability:

Organization Warning

This accountability status will be effective November 6, 2020 through May 31, 2021. During this time, the organization may forfeit privileges as outlined below. The warning could be reflected on the Student Organization Scorecard.

With respect to the information listed above, the following additional sanctions/stipulations apply:

1. Present university outcomes to ensure members understand the chapter's accountability status and can reflect on events. Present outcome letter to chapter members with 85% attendance. Provide meeting agenda and attendance to SAA by November 23, 2020.
2. Have 100% members attend "A New Kind of Safety" workshop from KD Headquarters. Submit agenda and attendance to SAA by November 16, 2020.
3. Create chapter wellness committee to be utilized for COVID-19 updates to be presented to the chapter. Submit wellness committee members and first report to SAA by November 16, 2020.

The following items will be completed by the deadline indicated and with verification of each item's completion submitted to Student Advocacy & Accountability using the [online reporting form](#) or via email to [REDACTED].

The Enhancement Plan and Accountability Outcome will be kept on file in Student Advocacy & Accountability within the Office of the Dean of Students. The Enhancement Plan will also be shared with all relevant LSU and headquarters staff.
