

FACULTY SENATE RESOLUTION 91-08

WHEREAS the faculty of Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College desire to have speakers of national stature deliver the spring commencement address, and

WHEREAS the recent economic situation of the State of Louisiana and of the University may preclude the expenditure of University funds for the purpose of defraying the expenses for such speakers, and

WHEREAS the University has had the extremely good fortune to have an alumnus in a position to relieve the University of financial burden, and

WHEREAS it is recognized that such future assistance may not always be available;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate recommends to the Louisiana State University Foundation that an endowment be established to provide funds to obtain speakers of national prominence for spring commencement exercises.
